

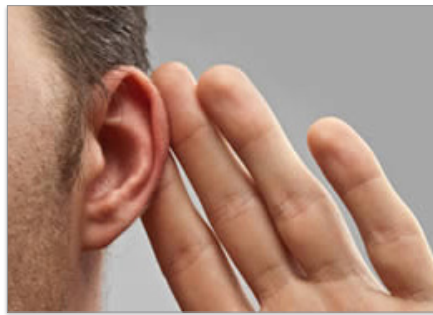
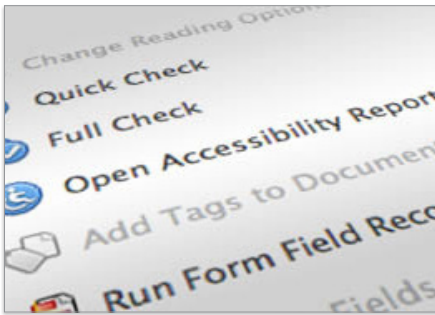


InDesign Accessibility | Course Overview

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This half-day course (online or face-to-face) focuses on using InDesign to create highly accessible PDFs. Such documents can be read by assistive technologies that aid people with disabilities including poor vision and limited mobility.

Creating accessible PDFs to WCAG 2.0 (Web Content Accessibility Guidelines) gives everyone, regardless of their abilities, access to the content in your documents. Australian government compliance now requires that all government website content, including PDFs, be accessible.

- What is an accessible PDF?
- Create and manipulate accessible PDFs (text and images) in InDesign
- Complete the accessible PDF creation process in Acrobat
- Checking PDFs for accessibility compliance
- Learn undocumented methods for creating compliant PDFs

It is essential that students have at least 1 to 2 years experience with InDesign or have completed the 2 day Adobe InDesign Essentials course. **An InDesign assessment is available if you are unsure of your InDesign user level.**

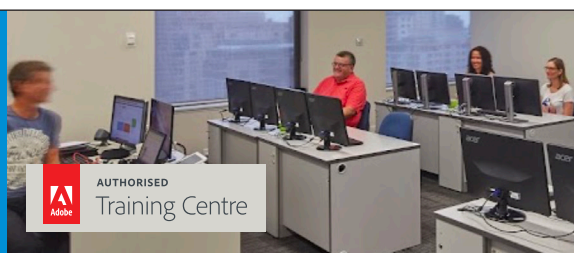
